The reception is the first gathering of this group, a celebration of the launch of the **UVA Professional Advisor Network (PAN)**.

The vision is to create a community of advisors who would like to have social and business connections with the University, and with alumni and friends who practice in complementary professions.

Another goal is to raise awareness about the Office of Gift Planning and the educational resources it can offer to advisors when they have clients who want to make a charitable gift.

The Gift Planning Council is an advisory committee that offers guidance and professional expertise to the Gift Planning program.

Members are volunteers who can provide expertise in such areas as taxes, accounting, marketing, real estate, and estate planning. They include alumni, faculty, and friends of UVA.
