OUR ADMISSIONS ARE BASED ON MERIT

At UVA, admission is based on students' academic merit, not on their ability to pay. We take care to assemble aid packages that may include grants, scholarships, work-study programs, and loans. Our admission decisions are based on students' intellectual abilities, academic achievements, and personal qualities. UVA is one of just two public universities to offer admission without regard to need and meet 100% of demonstrated need.

LIMITED STUDENT DEBT: UVA STUDENTS BORROW LESS

- 42% of U.S. public university graduates have zero student debt
- 38% of commonwealth of Virginia resident graduates have zero student debt
- 65% of UVA graduates have zero student debt
- \$4,500 is the average limit for need-based loans per year for in-state students
- \$7,000 is the average limit for need-based loans per year for out-of-state students
- \$27,800 is the national average debt for public university undergraduate degree holders with debt
- \$19,000 is the average debt for UVA undergraduate degree holders

WE INVEST IN ACCESS AND AFFORDABILITY

UVA's scholarship program has been growing rapidly since 2016 through a combination of institutional investments and private support. These endowed funds will provide scholarship resources in perpetuity.
