In 1998, UVA Professor and Center for Politics Director Larry J. Sabato founded the Youth Leadership Initiative to combat a growing sense of apathy and cynicism toward politics and government. Professor Sabato believed that by creating quality civics education programs, students would be energized to become lifelong participants in American democracy.
